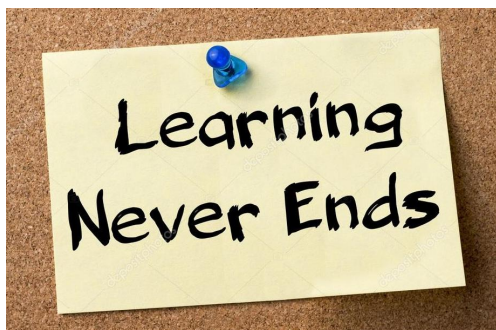
issues to vision, hearing, taste, and smell)
